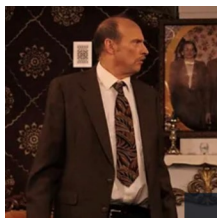


Lacy Baker

Baker, Coachman, & Ensemble

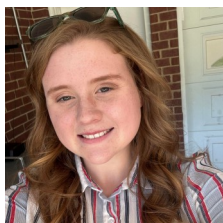

Kyleigh will be a senior at Greene County Tech High School this coming year. She has been in choir for four and a half years. This is her first show ever and she plans on doing many more.

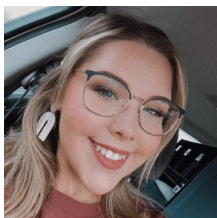


Pacey Bowen

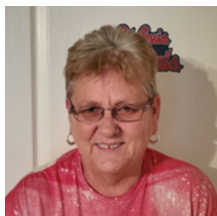


Ryan Hartness

Ensemble

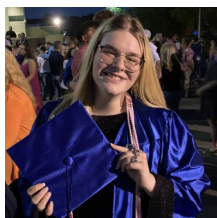

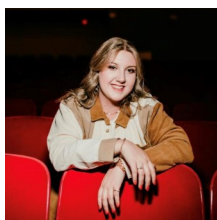

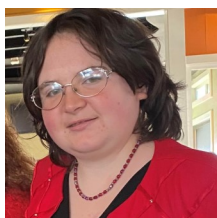

Ensemble

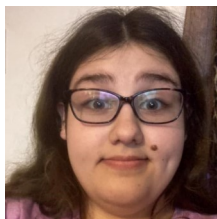

White Mouse

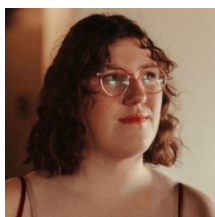
